The meeting started with a warm welcome to the New Chairman DRSC and an introductory from the members of different Stakeholders present.

The following decisions were taken in the meeting

1	As per prevailing guidance of Hon'ble CM on Road Safety, the Chairman DRSC directed the Stakeholders to take strong action for the enforcement of road safety protocols. Strict Vigilance to be observed against Drunk and reckless Driving, Bike stunts, Over speeding etc. during the Picnic & festive season.	District Administration, Traffic (Police), Transport Department, Excise etc.
2	Activation of iRAD by all concerned stakeholders within the next 30 days.	All Stakeholders like PWD(R), PWD(NH), NHAI, Transport Department etc.
3	A representative person from DDMA, GUCL, NHIDCL, APDCL to be included in the DRSC Committee.	District Administration
4	Each Road owning agencies has to depute a safety i/c for every repair/construction location, who shall report confirming that all steps are taken for traffic safety at such construction sites	PWD(R), PWD(NH), NHAI
5	Any request for fund requirement received to the DRSC by the Stakeholders, the Chairman DRSC shall approve and take necessary steps to procure expeditiously.	District Administration
6	Installation of hoarding by GMC to be done in consultation with road owning agencies. In case of disagreement, matter may be raised at DRSC level.	GMC, DIPRO

7	133 CrPC Order to be issued by DCP (Traffic) and GMC/Gaon Panchayat to take action against movement of Cattle on the Road to avoid accidents.	DCP(Traffic), GMC
8	Accident Prone locations involving poor visibility during night are to be identified and submit report to the DRSC for taking up the issues with GUSCL for installing adequate light at those locations.	Transport Department, Traffic Police
9	Road Accidents related to low median height at the stretch of Road NH-17 (Y-Intersection) near GU Bypass was discussed. As an intermediate measure, the EE PWD(NH) is directed to erect Rail Post on the median to prevent overturning of speeding vehicle on the other side of the median.	PWD (NH)
10	During discussion for arranging access to the pedestrians at Guwahati Bypass, the NHAI authority reveal that FOBs will be provided on specific locations of Guwahati NHAI Bypass after the completion of present ongoing project. However, for providing Temporary relief to the pedestrian for crossing the road, the NHAI authority directed to look into feasibility of providing median cut at specific location with provisions of revolving gate, necessary road Signage, road markings and zebra crossings etc.	NHAI
11	For all feeder roads connecting NH & SH, 2 Nos of speed breakers are to be installed at a distance of 20m & 40m from the junction with necessary road marking & road signages as per norms. On the main road also, there will be arrangement of road furniture etc. for indicating such connecting roads.	PWD (Roads), PWD(NH), NHAI
12	Any Unauthorised median to be closed.	PWD (Roads), PWD(NH), NHAI, Transport Department, Police
13	A detailed discussion was held for the 42 Nos. of Vulnerable locations identified as highly accident prone location, which were also jointly inspected by the concerned Road owning agencies, Police & officials of Transport Department. In this regard, all the concerned stakeholders are instructed to address the pending issues immediately.	PWD(R), PWD(NH), NHAI, GMC, Transport Department, Traffic Police, Excise
14	Local Police authority to submit list of accident prone locations on NH, irrespective of it classified as Blackspots or not to NHAI with copy to DRSC. NHAI has informed that as per latest directive they can take up repair activities based on requirement given by local police authority also.	PWD(NH), NHAI, Police
15	Discussion was held keeping in mind the emphasis put by the HCM in last 2 years on zero accidents on New Year's Eve. Accordingly, enforcement agencies like Excise, Transport and Police were instructed to increase road presence. Such activity to start from today itself and shall continue till 31 <sup>st</sup> January 2024,	Excise, Transport, Police
